Bar the above post, the Humanities Faculty consists of a full-time teacher of Geography, a part-time Geography teacher and a part-time Classics teacher who is also History qualified.

Expectations -

The list below is not exhaustive but gives a good indication of the key responsibilities of the job.

Specific Responsibilities -

- Collation of improvement plans for History and informing/reflecting the whole school plan with other staff members.
- Organisation of subject budget and resources.
- Promotion of Faculty activities and trips in line with school policy.
- Organisation of assessment, coursework and other SQA materials as required by the SQA coordinator.
- To actively support the marketing and promotion of the school.

Teaching Responsibilities –

- Overall responsibility for the delivery of History in the Senior School.
- Development and delivery of courses in line with the Scottish Curriculum for Excellence, N5, the new Higher course and Advanced Higher.
- Participation in the co-curricular programme.
- Reporting on progress and achievements of pupils.
- To act as a Form Teacher.

Personal Qualities & additional requirements –

The teacher of History should be able to demonstrate the qualities of anyone placed in a position of loco parentis – compassion, clarity and direction. The ability to lead and inspire colleagues and pupils as well as taking a flexible approach to learning is essential.

Terms and Conditions –

- To take up the post, a successful applicant must be registered with the General Teaching Council for Scotland or demonstrate the ability to be so.
- A successful PVG check will be required.
- A first aid at work or similar certificate would be useful but access to training will be given by Lathallan.
- Salary will be according to Lathallan salary scales.
- The position is pensionable under the Scottish Teachers' Superannuation Scheme.
- The appointment will be made subject to two satisfactory references being provided and a general application form being completed.

Closing Date –

- A letter of application and a CV with at least 2 references should be submitted to the School Secretary, office@lathallan.org.uk by Monday 19th March at 1pm. Interviews will take place during the week commencing 19th March with interviewed candidates expected to teach an S1, 2 or 3 lesson as part of the process (current topics are Impact of the Normans, Appeasement and the Middle Passage).
- The start date for this post would be 20th August.
